This workshop explores the basic tools of an actor's trade - observation, memorization, concentration, and imagination - in an entertaining way. Put Your Best Foot Forward	Get your groove on with this fun, physical workshop. Students will learn different styles of movement and dance used in Theatre to create an interpretive dance of a classic fairytale! This workshop is great for all levels of movers. Improv	Listening, creativity, bravery – all important skills for the Improv Actor to hone. This workshop emphasizes teamwork and "all-in" participation as the students learn to act without a script. Students of any experience level will be successful in this workshop.	
Behind the Scenes	Actors have very important jobs to do to tell a story, but there are so many people who make theatre magic happen before the curtain even rises!
