Missoula, MT: The Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) announces the 2025-2026 Community Series finale - *Mamma Mia!* *Voulez-vous* like to AUDITION for the chance to bring this international hit to the Missoula stage? If so, mark your calendars for Sunday, February 22nd from 12 Noon to 4 PM to sing and dance to the music by Sweden's pop group ABBA! Callbacks will begin after 4 PM. The show is rated PG-13 for adult language and situations. This is a 3-week run, with performances April 30-May 17, 2026. MCT now requests that people sign up for an audition time slot, minimizing wait times, but walk-ins are always welcome! Find the available time slots [Here](#).

Joseph Martinez (Director), Royce McIntosh (Music Director) and Alissa Tucker (Choreographer) are a star-studded creative team who will select a cast of 24 adults, ages 18 years and older. There are roles for 6 males, 6 females and an ensemble of 12. Roles include young Sophie, Sky (fiancé), Donna (Sophie's mom), 3 men - one of whom may be Sophie's real father - and friends coming for Sophie's wedding on a Greek Island, where it's a "Dancing Queen" kind of party with a "Thank You For The Music" vibe, featuring nearly two dozen of ABBA's hit songs woven into a musical story. The show is packed with disco, pop and rock music, so be prepared for lots of singing and dancing. (Bring a water bottle!). Guitar players are encouraged to audition.
