TITLE	DESCRIPTION	GRADES & CAPACITY
Drama Quest: Adventures in Antarctica!	A grand adventure in the world's largest desert, Antarctica, awaits! Using active and energetic role-playing in a dynamic group setting, students will develop problem-solving skills by communicating and using their imagination. Your students will have so much fun, they won't even realize that they're learning!	Grades 1-2 30 students <i>We ask that one representative from your organization be in the room during the workshop.</i>
Acting	"All the world's a stage," and all your students, merely players! This workshop explores the basic tools of an actor's trade - observation, memorization, concentration, and imagination - in an entertaining way. The students will participate in fun exercises, learning to apply these acting tools to performing and their everyday lives.	Grades 1-2 30 students
Behind the Scenes	Actors have very important jobs to do to tell a story, but there are so many people who make theatre magic happen before the curtain even rises! This workshop explores the world of Costume Design, Set Design, Theatre Marketing, and Makeup Design to give students a taste of the many artforms involved in making a performance great.	Grades 3-12 60 students <i>We ask that one representative from your organization be in the room during the workshop.</i>
Improv	Listening, creativity, bravery – all important skills for the Improv Actor to hone. This workshop emphasizes teamwork and "all-in" participation as the students learn to act without a script. Students of any experience level will be successful in this workshop.	<i>Workshop content will be tailored to the chosen age group and is most effective when limiting the age range of the participants to three or four grade levels within a particular session (i.e. 1-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12).</i>
Stage Makeup	Makeup is an important tool to enhance the work an actor does on stage when creating a character. This workshop teaches students of all ages by demonstrating (on a few participants) Corrective, Character, and Special Effects makeup for the theatre. Please note: this workshop is specific to theatre makeup techniques and is not a "face painting" experience.	
Role With It!	An entertaining and interactive assembly-style program designed to expand the imagination. The Tour Actor/Directors and the students create larger-than-life characters together, and voilà! A fun and compelling scene begins. Participants will act out short scenes embodying the characters they make up themselves. Note: The fee for this workshop is equivalent to three workshops.	Grades K-6 600 students <i>(Assembly/Performance Style) Grade level adjustments for this workshop can be made to accommodate special circumstances.</i>
